
TOMCAT SUNSET DECAL SET



for 6mmFlyRC's F-14 Tomcat

In September 2006 at Naval Air Station Oceana a final farewell ceremony was held to commemorate the F-14 Tomcat's 36 year service in the US Navy. This ceremony (and indeed the whole F-14 phasing out period) is generally referred to by the term "Tomcat Sunset", in reference to the conclusion of a great chapter in aviation history.

The VF-31 Tomcatters were the only squadron still equipped with F-14s during this period. Two of their remaining aircraft were painted in a special paint scheme devoid of individual squadron markings. One was painted in the low visibility scheme that the Tomcat bore in the latter half of its service life and the other, the aircraft depicted in this decal set, was painted in the high visibility scheme from the 70s and 80s.






